## **Kindergarten Arrival & Dismissal Procedures**

### **Morning Arrival 7:55 am - 8:15 am**

Please drop off your child at the walkway in front of the Early Childhood Center. The Kindergarten Aides will assist your child out of the car and will walk your child safely into class.

### **Late Arrivals- After 8:15 am**

Please report to the front office of the Main Building to receive a tardy slip before walking your child into the Early Childhood Center. All children are required to have a tardy slip before entering class.

**Important Note: Children should NOT be dropped off prior to 7:55 am, as there is no adult supervision. If you should require Early Morning Care, please contact the School Office.**

### **Dismissal- 2:45 pm**

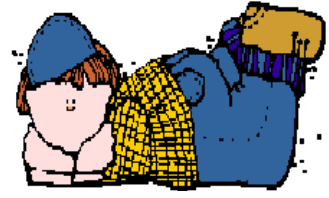
The children will be dismissed from inside the building as parents arrive to the front door of the Early Childhood Center. Please wait outside while your child is called to be dismissed. As this is a very busy time for the children and teachers, please be patient and try not to arrive early or unannounced.

### **Early Dismissal**

If you should require your child to be dismissed early, please be sure to send a note to your child's teacher. The office will be notified and we will make every effort to have your child ready at the time noted. Be sure to sign your child out at the front office in the Main Building before coming to the Early Childhood Center for pick up.



## St. Bernadette Kindergarten Supply List

The fee for these items will be \$25 for the rest mat and \$20 for the "Hangeroo". Please send a separate check for each item, payable to St. Bernadette School. Please do not send cash. All forms and monies should be placed in an envelope and sent to the Main Office prior to the start of school.

**Note:** *If your child attended the St. Bernadette Preschool and you purchased a rest mat, there is no need to purchase a new one. Please bring the mat on the first day of school. The Hangeroo will follow your child to 1<sup>st</sup> grade.*

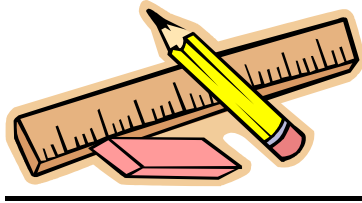
